

BIOGRAPHY OF KENNETH E. IVERSON



Ken Iverson received the B.A. degree in Mathematics and Physics at Queen's University in Kingston, Ontario, in 1950. He holds an A.M. in Mathematics (1951) and a Ph.D. in Applied Mathematics (1954), both from Harvard. He was an Assistant Professor of Applied Math at Harvard from 1955 to 1960 and then joined IBM as a Research Staff Member. He was made an IBM Fellow in 1971.

He received the AFIPS Harry Goode Award in 1975 and was given ACM's Turing Award in 1979.
